Jay's personal interests include music and amateur radio. He also has written a juggling act communicating the Gospel, having ministered this in a wide variety of settings.

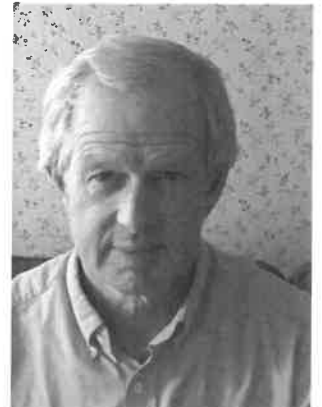
## First Vice President, Mr. Robert Clapp
